Unemployment started to drop in March and April

Most came in for assistance in more than one area, computers and unemployment were the most common. JCDJFS held open interviews in April for the children’s home.

**AD/DW WIOA**

Have been working on clearing the wait list, the increase of new participants reflects this.

**Business Services**

Job posting daily from Dan Wilson to post in job center. These are posted in the job center and on socials. Often time the case managers send directly to the participants. Case managers also working with Dan for individuals as well. Dan has been contacting business for the Jefferson County Job Fair.

**CCMEP Youth**

Wait list has been cleared. There have been a few more OWF mandatory participants brought on CCMEP, some have been sanctioned and them reapplied. Case managers are doing the eligibly on the SYP participants for the summer working. CCMEP participants are also getting placed for the summer.

**Other Events and Information**

GRIT : Working the Jefferson Drug court, Milton Recovery and now EOCC. There have been 3 work experience placements, and there are a couple more in progress of placement. There have been a few participants that were over income for WIOA AD that GRIT funds will be used to help with the tuition, and support. GRIT has also been used to assist CCMEP TANF youth that was not eligible for WIOA IN (no barriers) to keep them in their work experience after graduation to keep them on track.
